Job Summary

Saik'uz First Nation Guardians play a crucial role in the Land and Resource Department's goal of increasing jurisdiction and implementing Dakelh laws and principles around the stewardship of Saik'uz Keyoh by collecting current state information which feeds back into governance frameworks of the Nation to support decision making. The Guardians will support various initiatives and projects under the Land and Resource Department such as Noolhk'ai-Tachek-Tsink'ut Pilot Project, Resource Management Planning, Nechakoh technical monitoring projects, Yinka Dene Water Law Implementation, and general conservation monitoring. This includes but is not limited to water quality, fisheries, and wildlife monitoring. Additionally, the Guardians will support land-based healing initiatives including cultural camps.

- Support the protection and stewardship of Saik'uz Keyoh
- Collection of data for various field programs both aquatic and terrestrial
- Support Land and Resource Department workplan and objectives
- Liaise and participate the Traditional Governance Oversight Committee where necessary
- Liaise, and uphold positive relationships with Saik'uz members, neighbouring Carrier Sekani First Nations, NFNs, proponents, and government representatives.
