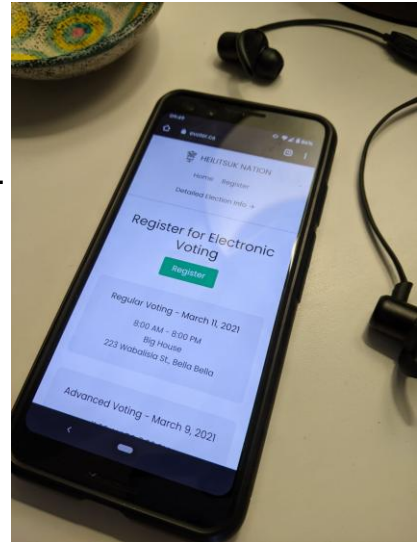




Saik'uz First Nation Electronic Voting

REGISTER NOW for Online Voting

Online voting begins March 20 @ 9am, but you may register in advance! If you registered to vote online for the 2024 referendum, you remain registered for the 2025 elections and should not need to register again. New online voters must first register at www.evoter.ca.



What you will need:

- Status Card Number (Registry Number)
- Your Date of Birth
- Your email address
- Internet enabled computer, phone or tablet

How to Register:

- Visit <https://evoter.ca/>
 1. Click the Green **Register** button.
 2. Enter your Status Card Number and Date of Birth.
 3. Click the Green **Submit** button.
 4. Enter at least your email address. Update any other contact information you like.
 - Be sure your email address is correct.
 5. Click the Green **Submit** button.
- Check your email for a verification link
 - If you don't see the email, please check your Junk or Spam folder.
 - Click on the **Verify Email Now** button in the email to activate your online voting.

How to Vote:

- Another email with a link to the voting platform will arrive from vote@simplyvoting.com within 24 hours of your registration.
- The email will include a link to the voting process as well as your voting pin number.
- Follow the instructions to complete your vote.
 - Note: We cannot access any results until after Voting Day is completed.
 - Note: You will be taken off the in person voting list if you vote online.
